Dr. David Lee Dai Wee is a consultant clinical oncologist and lecturer at the University of Malaya Medical Centre, having received his medical education from the International Medical University (IMU) in Malaysia and a Master of Clinical Oncology from the University of Malaya in 2020, alongside obtaining FRCR (Clinical Oncology) in 2022. He completed a fellowship in experimental therapeutics at the National Cancer Centre Singapore, contributing to over 40 early-phase clinical trials, with a focus on early-phase clinical trials, thoracic oncology, and head and neck oncology. Notably, Dr. Lee was awarded the inaugural American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) Leadership Development Program - Asia Pacific award in 2021-2022 and is actively involved in various ASCO committees, including the Trainee and Early Career Advisory Group, Membership Advisory Group, and the IASLC Multidisciplinary Clinical Science Committee.
