Dr. Siau Ching Sin is a Senior Lecturer in the Centre for Community Health Studies (ReaCH) and the Health Education Programme. Her expertise is in suicide and its prevention, and mental health concerns among a wide range of populations, including health professionals. Recognizing that the hospital is a potential setting to encounter and intervene with individuals with suicidality, her work had focussed on health professionals' attitudes toward suicidal patients, and at the same time the burdens faced by health professionals as they juggle between their own welfare and the patients'. Her research in gatekeeper suicide training among health professionals has been featured in the World Health Organization's publication, LIVE LIFE: An Implementation Guide for Suicide Prevention in Countries.
