Dr. Mohamad Haniki Nik Mohamed, Pharm.D, holds a Bachelor of Pharmacy with Honors from Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM) since 1993, followed by a Pharm.D and Post-Doctorate Fellowship from the University of Tennessee, Memphis in 1997. He has since served as a Lecturer in Clinical and Administrative Pharmacy at USM from 1997 to 2005 and as an Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Pharmacy Practice at the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) since 2005. Notable contributions include establishing the first multidisciplinary quit smoking clinic at USM in 2002, teaching pharmacy practice and clinical pharmacy topics with innovative methods, and holding key roles in various organizations and committees related to tobacco control. He has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals and books, focusing on smoking cessation and related topics. Currently, his research interests lie in the cost-effectiveness of quit smoking clinics, community pharmacists' knowledge and practices, and the impact of graphic health warnings on Malaysian cigarette packs. Dr. Mohamed has received research grants and travel fellowships from local and international bodies and aims to further contribute to the pharmacy profession's practice, policies, and education as a member of the Malaysian Pharmaceutical Society (MPS) Council.
